Course completion

The nationally agreed time for course completion is 281 hours. However, students undertaking the course with our college take approximately 4 to 6 weeks to finish. There is no time restriction and you may choose to complete studies in more or less time.

Register to work 'under supervision'

You can apply for registration 'under supervision'. To do this you must provide proof of enrolment in one of the relevant qualifications, as required by SA Consumer and Business Services with your application.

It is expected that you will complete the training within 12 months.
